

# H. A. MOSES GIVES TRINITY CARILLON

## Bell Set Will Boast Three Full Octaves and Will Weigh 48,000 Pounds—Contract Signed

A 60-bell carillon will be placed in the tower of the new Trinity Methodist Episcopal church as a gift to the church and community from Horace A. Moses, Mr Moses announced last night at the banquet of the Federated Men's clubs at Faith Congregational church. The contract for the bells has been signed, he said.

Four full octaves will be the scale range of the bells, and there will be double bells for the last 13 notes. The total weight of the carillon will be 48,000 pounds, the largest bell weighing 8000 pounds. The carillon will be one which can be played either automatically or by hand and will sound the hours and half hours throughout the day. Western Union time will be used.

Mr Moses said he hopes there will be a concert hour Sunday afternoons after the carillon is in place. He explained that the bells form a gift to the community as a whole rather than to Trinity church itself.
