

CONSIDER CARILLON FOR TRINITY CHURCH

A strong possibility exists that a full carillon of 47 bells will be installed at Trinity church when the church auditorium is completed a year or 18 months hence and the tower of the church group has been raised to the height designated in the original plans.

Installation of a carillon depends upon several things, including the temporary financing of the building program, but prominent members of the church society are confident that these conditions will be overcome and that within the next year or two Springfield will enjoy the distinction of having the first carillon in this section of New England.

Although the idea has not been made public the question of installing a carillon has been in the minds of certain members of the church for some time. The church is considered ideally located for it. Standing as it does with the trees of Forest park as a background and with a wealth of open space around it, the church group is so situated that experts are certain that the tones of a carillon would sound to excellent advantage. The tower has been planned from the first to house a chime, but recently it has been considered that a carillon would be far more appropriate.
