

# Church Plays New Carillon

A new 47-bell carillon, specially built in Holland, was dedicated yesterday at the Church of the Covenant, 11205 Euclid Avenue.

The bells arrived last week by Norwegian freighter from Holland. They cost in excess of \$50,000.

The bells are a gift to the church from the family of the late Dr. Alexander McGaffin, who was copastor at the time of its building in 1911.

Twenty-seven of the bells are wired to the organ, and can be played by Dr. Henry Fusner, organist. The dedicatory recital was played yesterday by Arie Abbenes, a Dutch carillonneur.
