

The smallest bell weighs 29 pounds, is eight inches in diameter and is tuned to an E flat four octaves higher in

TWENTY-SEVEN of the Covenant bells will be wired electrically to the console of home constituency, to with the Covenant organ and Dr. musical director, will be able to play them directly from the organ.

Three of the 47 bells will swing freely. These will be used as a peal of bells and to sound the call to worship. A clavier or keyboard will be connected to all 47 bells. It will be housed in a room directly below the bells, which are to be more than 100 feet

above street level. Walls of the McGaffin Tower are more than three feet thick, a necessity with a musical mastodon whose vibrations would surely crack less massive walls.
