

Episcopal Church Dedicates Bells

The recently installed bells at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Cleveland Heights, will be formally dedicated at the 11 a. m. service tomorrow.

Dr. Kamiel Lefevere, world-renowned carillonneur of Riverside Church, New York, will play a dedicatory recital at 3:30 p. m. He will also play before and after the church services.

The set of 23 bells, which are played from large wooden levers by hand, is believed to be the only complete carillon in this area.

Lefevere, who is one of the top-ranking masters of this little-practiced art, recently gave a concert in Greenwood, S. C., to which an estimated crowd of 25,000 listened from parked automobiles.
